**Morning and Afternoon Routines @ St Mark's** - I'm sure that all families would agree with me that they wish for the optimum learning opportunities to be provided for their children at St Mark's each and every day. We all know that a smooth and stress free start for each child is vital for learning and wellbeing. In light of this, I ask that parents ensure that students are on time each day. Our teachers are in classrooms at 8.45am and are available to talk with parents until 8.50am when administrative tasks such as calling the role are performed. This time is also when the students begin the day in a prayerful way with their teacher and classmates. School staff are unable to supervise the Adventure Playground at pick up time as they are required to supervise the collection of the children to ensure that all students are picked up safely.

It is very important that you drop students off in designated areas and do not stop in no standing zones.
